The RDR also welcomes submissions on innovative programs or practices, and work focused on under-explored issues, gaps and stakeholders.

- The length of abstracts should not exceed 300 words
- Abstracts should include the proposed title of the final paper
- A cover letter with your full name, phone number, e-mail address and the organization / institution / network / group you are affiliated with.

- The deadline for submitting the **final paper** is May 02, 2022 - **Deadline extended to May 16, 2022**
- The final paper should be between 8 to 10 pages (double-spaced)
